Sept. 1862 - June 1910 ↳ pen name

American - North Carolina
moved to Texas - singer/
musician

- draftsman
worked in a bank
accused of embezzlement

↳ prison - prison pharmacist
- taking from somewhere you work

↳ published 14 stories while in prison (3 years) under pen names

- moved to New York City - 381 5th Street

- plot twists/surprise endings stories
