<p>What is your favorite number? Why is it your favorite number? Draw a picture displaying your favorite number.</p>	<p>Start at 10 and count backwards by 1's. How did you do?</p>	<p>Sing the "Days of the Week" song. What is today? What was yesterday?</p>	<p>Line up 10 of your toys. Which one is first? Which was is last?</p>	<p>Make your bed. What did you do first? What did you do next, and last?</p>
<p>Practice writing numbers. How high did you go? Are the numbers in order?</p>	<p>Collect treasures from outside. How could you sort your treasures?</p>	<p>Make a pattern from things found outside.</p>	<p>Puzzle Day! Try making a puzzle using an old coloring book page. Put it back together.</p>	<p>What is your favorite flavor of ice cream? Ask 4 people the same question. Have an adult help you make a graph.</p>
<p>Make a pattern. Have a family member continue the pattern.</p>	<p>Fill a string with pasta shapes. How many pieces did you use?</p>	<p>Use a snack to make a pattern. Example: cracker, apple slice, cracker, apple slice</p>	<p>Play "Simon Says." Use words like over, under, in front, behind, beside.</p>	<p>Use play dough to make numbers 1-10.</p>
<p>Go to the library and look for a number book with a family member. Identify the numbers.</p>	<p>Find 5 things in your house that come in pairs.</p>	<p>Look inside a grocery store flyer. Cut out the numbers 1-20 and paste them in order on a sheet of paper.</p>	<p>Line up your friends from shortest to tallest.</p>	<p>Collect shoes from different family members. Match up the pairs. Sort them into different groups.</p>
